I am pleased to report that a \$15,000 expense budget is ready to submit. Included is \$6,000 for parish improvements and \$2,000 for robes and ceremonials.

A few areas needing the council's attention include:

- First Friday benediction, all-night adoration and First Saturday Mass. We hope to improve participation by birthday month. So, if your birthday is in July, try to sign for adoration.
 - Fish dinners in Lent. We need multiple chairmen. Brother Bernie Holland has agreed to chair one Friday. Call Fran Vendetta if you are available Friday afternoons in Lent.
 - Free throw contest for teens. A project chair is needed.
- Finally, goodbye and farewell to Brother Bob Swiderski and his family. You have served the council long and well.
