Business Meeting Notes - July 10, 2019

Prior to the meeting Ellen Laughery was recognized by the Council as the Lady of the Year with Mike Croyle reading his write up for her nomination. Ellen was then presented a plaque by Grand Knight Frank Hare.

Dan M. Murphy then introduced Pat Wallace, President of St. Vincent de Paul Society at Seton. Pat thanked the Council for our \$XXX donation. He stated they have worked with 53 families this year, 95% are within 4 miles of the Church. During the 1st Qtr. they ran out of funds, their support comes from the collection following Masses at the end of each month. They are collaborating with other churches in the Pickerington area. Their 1st screening is to refer the individual or family in need to 211 and Fairfield County conducts an assessment, then two members make a home visit to have the person explain their needs. Every Weds. the Lancaster trunk is in the Pickerington area, just call them and they will pick up furniture at your house.

Grand Knight Frank Hare called the official meeting to order at 7:30 pm and announced the next Officer Meeting is 8/6/19 and the Council meeting will be moved to 8/7/19 with a new starting time of 7 pm.

Roll Call of Officers: Missing were the Chaplain, Inside Guard, Outside Guard, and 1st Year Trustee, all excused. Wayne Patterson motioned to approve the minutes from last month's meeting, Dick Petersen 2nd. Voted upon and passed.
