In 1999, Dr. William Lile and a partner bought out one of the busiest Florida abortion clinics, immediately ending the abortions there and putting the previous provider into retirement. Dr. Lile then began to use the tools once used for destroying innocent life to defend it. His passion for protecting the unborn grew, lending him the nickname "The Pro-Life Doc". Today he continues to practice medicine, teach, and speak out in defense of human life. Dr. Lile has reached a national audience with his perspective on extreme abortion laws, like the ones passed in New York and proposed in Virginia, which he responds to from both medical and scriptural perspectives and by his work on abortion pill reversal and rescue, which he not only provides in-clinic but serves on the medical advisory board for at Heartbeat International.


