Business Meeting Notes - August 7, 2019

Roll Call of Officers: Missing were the Chaplain, Chancellor, and Outside Guard, all excused. Wayne Patterson motioned to approve the minutes from last month's meeting, Mike Croyle 2nd. Voted upon and passed.

Chaplains Report: Absent, no report.

Membership and Reading of Applications: Shawn Roberts, no admissions, one transfer.

Grand Knight's Report: GK Frank Hare pointed out that the newsletter has been published by Jesus Garcia, thanked him. Time for the Seton Festival, Knights are very active, need our support, encourage family and friends to volunteer, will need manpower next Weds to help set up. Thanked the Knights for helping with the Gospel Road event, "God is Good", great program for the Parish.

Note in the Newsletter the "Scripture Thought for the Month" and also anniversaries of Brother Knights. 6 Officers attended the Road Show, new motto is "We Are Many, We Are One", plan to discuss programs at next Officers meeting. Our Council mentioned in "The Villa Pulse" newsletter, John Samborsky's son is a resident at St. John's Villa. The installation of Officers by the District Deputy will occur at the September meeting. The Seton Bowling League will be starting on 9/15/19, every other Sunday, if interested let him know.

Youth Director: Wayne Patterson reported that a very good Leadership Retreat occurred this past weekend, a new Team is starting to plan the Confirmation Retreat. Kids are going to have a pancake breakfast as a fund raiser on 9/15/19.
