At the clinic on East Main Street a contingent group of Knights and Ladies prayed the rosary, and handed out 'comfort bags' to the women entering the facility. These bags were provided by funds from our council from last year's budget. The 'Silver Rose' is a pilgrimage of an Icon traveling from Canada to Mexico. At each stop along the route councils pray for respect for life, spiritual renewal of each nation,

and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This year the program was done virtually. Thank you to those from our council that participated in both these events.
