Grand Knight Thom Laughery called the official meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

Roll Call of Officers: Missing were the Chaplain, Chancellor, Advocate, Outside Guard and Lecturer all excused. Wayne Patterson motioned to approve the minutes from last month's meeting, Ralph Blamer 2nd. Voted upon and passed.

Chaplains Report: Absent, no report.

Grand Knight's Report: GK Thom Laughery wished the Council a Happy Anniversary as 10/12/20 was the 27th anniversary for Council 11187. Award dinners for this year have been cancelled due to Covid-19. The Food Drive was a success with 2,950 lbs. of food and \$1,526 donated, this was the biggest amount ever donated to the Pickerington Food Pantry. The Fish Fry on 9/25/20 was a success with 281 people served, proud of all Knights stepping up to get it done. On 11/1/20 at the 11:30 am Mass, the first two pews will be reserved for the Knights and their families as this is for Father McGivney's Beatification, a parish priest who has become a saint. On 10/21/20 at 7:30 pm there will be a webinar -Financial Planning Seminar, he will send an email with more details.

Treasurer Report: Dan Murphy sent out the financial report to the officers and program chairs, let him know if there are any questions, all entries have been properly reconciled. We will need to develop a budget for the 2nd half of the Fraternal Year beginning 1/1/21, he will send an email asking for your thoughts, input for both income and expenses. Has paid \$175.21 for 4 month of Liability Insurance as the policy year is changing from a October 1st to February 1st date.

The 2021 Dues statements will be issued on 12/15/20, encourages everyone to pay them on line.
