Grand Knight Thom Laughery called the official meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

On 11/1/20 at the 11:30 am Mass, the first two pew will be reserved for the Knights and their families as this is for Father McGivney's Beatification, a parish priest who has become a saint. On 10/21/20 at 7:30 pm there will be a webinar -Financial Planning Seminar, he will send an email with more details.

Treasurer Report: Dan Murphy sent out the financial report to the officers and program chairs, let him know if there are any questions, all entries have been properly reconciled. We will need to develop a budget for the 2nd half of the Fraternal Year beginning 1/1/21, he will send an email asking for your thoughts, input for both income and expenses.
