Customers were very appreciative and requested we have a fish fry every Friday! Again, great job by the Knights participating. We could have used more workers, please get involved.

Well, what's next? I'm not going to let this council rest. Another Fish Fry is scheduled for October 16th. A "Coats for Kids" drive is coming soon, watch the bulletin and emails for more information.

November 1st is the Beatification of our founder, Fr. Michael McGivney. To become a saint is what the Lord had in mind for McGivney. His insight in forming the Knights of Columbus has reaped extraordinary results and with the Lord's help has saved many lives and restored pride to people. Since all new members are via the On-Line application, the Financial Secretary is no longer involved with new membership.

Fish Fry: Frank Hare discussed the Fish Fry will be Friday, 9/25/20,

from 4:30 to 7 pm, carry out only, cost is \$10. Menu will be 2 pieces of fried fish, macaroni, coleslaw and tartar sauce. Will need at least 8 volunteers, if still have fish left over, a second one will be 10/16/20.

Public Relations: Francis Wilamosky asked if anyone is interested in taking over the K of C shirt program. If anyone needs a shirt, cost is \$15, let him know. For the Food Drive, if we can get 200 people donating 10 items it would be great.

GK Thom Laughery would like 3 or 4 guys to review the recent Member Survey results and then create an action plan.

Shawn Roberts indicated that there will be a 20-minute film on Father McGivney at 8 pm on 9/26/20, he will send out an email with the information.
