Membership Meeting Notes - August 12, 2020

Grand Knight Thom Laughery called the official meeting held via Zoom to order at 7:01 pm.

Roll Call of Officers: Missing was the Chaplain, Financial Secretary, and Treasure, all excused. Wayne Patterson motioned to approve the minutes from last month's meeting, Bob Coholich 2nd. Voted upon and passed.

Chaplains Report: Absent, no report.

Membership and Reading of Applications: Tim Lee, one transfer from Cincinnati, Chris Swails who introduced himself. We also have two new members, Jonathan Thomas who works in the Columbus Police Dept. and Andy Reitz who is an attorney, both signed up on line and will be taking their 1st/2nd/3rd degree on line.

Grand Knight's Report: GK Thom Laughery received Thank You notes from Lady of the Year Award winners - Brenda Wooley, Rosa Krummen and Mary Monk; an email from the Youth of the Year -Declan Patterson; and a Thank You card from Miranda Donley for the money our Council donated for the "Goodie Bags" that Students for Life pass out at abortion clinics. Free on-line membership is extended until 8/31/20, no dues for new members for this year. Received the Grand Knight letter indicating we have 256 members, 79 insurance members, 21 honoree life, 11 honoree, and 10 inactive. The results of the Member Survey were emailed to all members, received 51 Responses, 50 are satisfied with their membership, 46 think the Knights are visible in the Parish, 32 are willing to participate in a council committee, 14 have a special trade, skill or talent they can offer the council, 43 willing to volunteer one hour of their time over the next year. Overall, positive responses, thought it was worthwhile, and would now like to set up a committee to review the survey results and create an action plan. Along with Deputy Grand Knight, he will be meeting with Father Jim and Jim McQuaide on 8/13/20 to discuss having a Food Drive, Blood Drive and Coat Drive. State on-line training is needed for The Grand Knight and the Program Director.
